



2020-2021 | CAPTAIN JUDY CAMERON SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

About the Scholarship

Requirements

The scholarship—awarded by Air Canada—targets women in pursuit of non-traditional aviation careers as commercial pilots or aircraft maintenance engineers who may not have the financial means to do so.

The applicants are Canadian citizens and have been accepted in a post-secondary aviation flight (fixed wing) program at a college, university, or flight school, or an aircraft repair and maintenance program anywhere in Canada.

Scholarship amount

The CA\$20,000 a year will be divided amongst selected recipients at the discretion of the selection committee, and each selected recipient will receive an amount up to CA\$5,000.

Renewal

The scholarship is not automatically renewable but the successful 2019-2020 recipients (along with other candidates) may reapply for the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 scholarships.

Selection committee and timeline

The selection committee will be composed of Northern Lights Aero Foundation members, Air Canada representatives and one independent person from the aviation industry. Successful applicants will be notified via email by January 25, 2021.

What type of personal information is collected?

- We collect the name, address, email address, phone number and personal financial information and Class One Medical (for pilots)
- We also collect information on your post-secondary studies

Why is this personal information collected?

We need this information to:

- identify you
- contact you about the results of your application
- keep a register of past applicants
- demonstrate you meet the financial need requirement

How is this personal information protected?

This information is stored in Northern Lights Aero Foundation systems with appropriate safeguards. Only the person receiving the applications will have access to all personal information. The selection committee are the only ones authorized to consult and use the information. The names and contact information will be removed from the files for their review. Only after selection, will the names of the selected candidates be revealed to the selection committee, for the purposes indicated.

How long do we retain this information?

We retain all information for the duration of the selection process. Once the winners are selected, the information will be kept for 1 year, in case a scholarship recipient discontinues their studies and we must select another candidate. The information will be deleted after one year.

- Your immediate (5 years) and future (10 years) goals, indicating your commitment to career in aviation
- Your plan to achieve your goals and the steps you've taken so far to achieve them
- Your challenges and setbacks—how you have handled adversity in any area of your life?
- Your participation in organizations that promote women in aviation and any other volunteer work
- Please provide any other additional information that makes your application stand out from other applicants
